People sometimes feel their lives are unfolding in too good a way. They may even say that the goodness scares them a bit. The implication is clear: They are not sure life has the right to be that good. Consequently, they wait for the "other shoe to drop."

An old Peanuts cartoon comes to mind finds Lucy saying her prayers. When she is finished, she walks into the kitchen where Linus is eating and comments: "I was praying for greater patience and understanding, but I quit ..." In the last frame, she continues: "I was afraid I might get it."

James Evans McReynolds was onto something when he wrote:

Whatever else the resurrection of Jesus means, it means that God is getting close to us.

We fear that. Easter, we say, is a day of joy and it really is. We say it is a day of hope and it really is. We say it is a day of promise and it really is. But we are not as fond of it as we think. We are afraid of it. We are more afraid of it than we will ever say.

Good news, here, but frankly, it makes us shake in our shoes. So little wonder that Jesus says to these shaking, quaking disciples: "Peace be with you." Or to put it colloquially, "Chill! It's going to be fine. I know you don't understand how all this has come to pass, but it's going to be all right. In fact, very all right. Maybe I'm starting to get it ... Everything is going to be all right!

What about you? Do you get it? Remember, we are Easter People, so, chill! It's going to be fine! I know you don't understand it all right now, but everything's going to be all right!
