

We get this comforting idea that if we follow the Messiah, life will somehow be smoother, or at least it will all fit together in some "good" way. Then we run smack into the reality that the only guarantee Jesus made to us is that his followers would most likely have a harder time getting through this life than those who walked away. But we still have these expectations of a "Savior" and when Jesus doesn't meet them, we begin to wonder if he

is really who we thought he was.

There are thousands of empty church pews that used to be full of people who believed in Jesus Christ. But then he didn't live up to their expectations and they went home. Their families still fought, they still had some frightening decisions to make, and they still couldn't make ends meet on a budget. They still had their health issues to deal with and tragedies to handle. They began to wonder if they had made a mistake with Jesus.

Maybe that's what happened to John. John said that he had come to baptize with water, and that the one following him would baptize with "fire from heaven."

So where was the fire?

So far there wasn't even smoke.

So far, the Pharisees and Sadducees were still in charge of the faith, and Rome was still in charge of the government. In fact, instead of bringing in the kingdom, Jesus had kept pretty quiet up north while John got himself into hot water with the King then ended up getting arrested and thrown into one of Herod's dungeons on a mountaintop down by the Dead Sea. That might make a person ask some questions. Is this any way for a Messiah to behave?

At least I hope that's what happened with John. If John the Baptist, as high up as he ranked, still had some questions, maybe there is room for me and mine. Maybe there's room for you as well. We ask many times, "Are you the one? Where are you?" But do we dare to hear and see His response? It might now be your time or mine right now but look around you, look and see that the blind see and the lame walk and the deaf hear, the dead have been raised and the poor have the good news preached to them!"

It may not be my time or yours yet, but because of what you see and hear, trust that He is the One for you!
