Cole shook his head and said, "You were praying for the people who were screaming at you?" She said, "Yes, my mama taught me that when people speak mean of you, you pray for them just like Jesus prayed for the people who spoke mean of him."

You see what awesome, transforming power that happens when Jesus is alive in you and fills your heart! There's no room for evil to exist and you just can't help but speak healing, love and forgiveness - and God knows we need a whole lot more of that than anything else!
