The daughter of some friends of mine called home, talked to her parents about the great disappointment in her life, how she feels. She talks about what she can do now. They talk about all this. At the end the parents say, "We wish we could do something." She says, "You have done a lot just being there. I can feel your love. It helps. Thanks for being there."

Just as Jesus, at critical times in his life, went apart to hear those words again, so at critical moments in our lives, when we need to be reminded of who we are, when we need to have renewed direction and purpose and power in our lives, there will be our own personal epiphanies, those times when once again we will hear, "You are my daughter," or "You are my son" and find the strength to be lifted up beyond the muck and mire of the moment to the new places God is calling us to.

Listen throughout this New Year for the voice of God and see what a difference it will make as God speaks to "my beloved sons and daughters!
