

Dear friends,

A cartoon appeared in the NEW YORKER magazine. Approaching a small bridge plainly marked, "Load Limit 8 tons" was a truck, also marked on its side, "8 tons." When the 8 ton truck was about in the middle of the bridge with the 8 ton limit, a bluebird landed on the top girder. At that point the bridge gave way and crashed with the truck into the river below, to the obvious surprise of the bluebird.

The bridge was built, as indicated for 8 tons; the truck weighed exactly that. The bridge could hold up under its load limit, but not under 8 tons plus one bluebird.

Of course, this story is wonderfully ridiculous. Most bridges could stand up under their load limit and several thousand bluebirds on top of that. But, to be sure, all bridges have a breaking point somewhere "that point at which the bluebird would be just too much. But, friends, it really isn't the bluebird that breaks it down. It is the fact that 8 tons are already present.

We all have bluebird troubles, don't we? We are all burdened by the facts of our lives which load us to the point of "load limit." We let little things get the best of us, little bluebirds of nothingness, tiny bluebirds of no importance, but just the thing to bring us down. Every person has a limit and we would do well to watch for the warning signs of one bluebird too many. There is always a load limit. Perhaps that is why Jesus chided her saying, "Martha, you are troubled and burdened by many things when only one is necessary and Mary has chosen the better part and it will not be taken from her." Perhaps better yet is the point that Jesus was making: if we would only take all of our troubles and burdens to the Lord in the first place, we wouldn't collapse under their weight ... None of those "bluebirds" could ever trouble us to the point that they could ever bring us down!

When you take your troubles and worries to the Lord and leave them there you chose the better part – the part that strengthens and empowers you, bringing out the best in you! Don't be deprived of what God has in store for you.
