Black Catholic History Month

The first celebration of Black Catholic History Month in the United States began in November of 1990 in various cities with the celebration of St. Martin de Porres' Feast day. The liturgy celebrated the 350th anniversary of St. Martin's transition from this life to eternal life. Some people forget that Christianity did not originate in Europe and even express surprise when they learn that Black Catholic History began in the Acts of the Apostles (8:26-40) with the conversion of the Ethiopian Europe by Philip the Deacon.

Three popes—Saints Victor I, Melchiades, and Gelasius I—were born in Africa and led the early church through much turmoil. There are also many Black Catholic saints: St. Monica of Hippo, St. Augustine of Hippo, St. Perpetua, St. Felicity, St. Moses The Black, St. Martin de Porres, St. Josephine Bakhita, St. Bessarion, St. Benedict the Moor, St. Antonio Vieira, and St. Anthony the Great of Thebes, to name a few.

Most recently, we celebrate that on October 25, 2020, Pope Francis named Washington's Archbishop Wilton Gregory to Cardinal, the first African American Cardinal in the U.S.


- You will only have 3 minutes in the voting booth to cast your ballot, so fill out your sample ballot and bring it with you!
