Be Prepared To Cast Your Vote

Many of your voting questions can be answered by going to the Secretary of State's website at voterportal.sos.la.gov

You can access this information on your phone or mobile device by uploading the GeauxVote app.

When you go to the voter portal:

- Click on Search by Voter,
- Type in your information,
- Your page has links to:
 - -Check your Registration or Register to Vote
 - -Request an Absentee Ballot and check its status
 - -Find Your Polling Location
 - -View your Sample Ballot

Mail-In Voting:

- Apply for your Mail-In Ballot at voterportal
- Follow All Instructions
 - -Do not remove the affidavit flap
 - -Sign the affidavit
 - -Have a witness sign the affidavit
- Return your ballot by:
 - -USPS to PO Box with 2 Forever stamps!
 - -FedEx or UPS to 222 St. Louis St, BR LA
 - -In Person at Early Voting Sites or the Registrar's Office

In Person Voting

- You will only have 3 minutes in the voting booth **Election Day Voting Location:** to cast your ballot, so fill out your sample ballot and bring it with you!
- Poll workers are required to wear masks, but voters are not, so take precautions
- If you receive a Mail-In Ballot and did not send it in, you may vote in person.
- Vote at Early Voting locations Oct. 16-27 or your polling location on election day - Nov. 3
