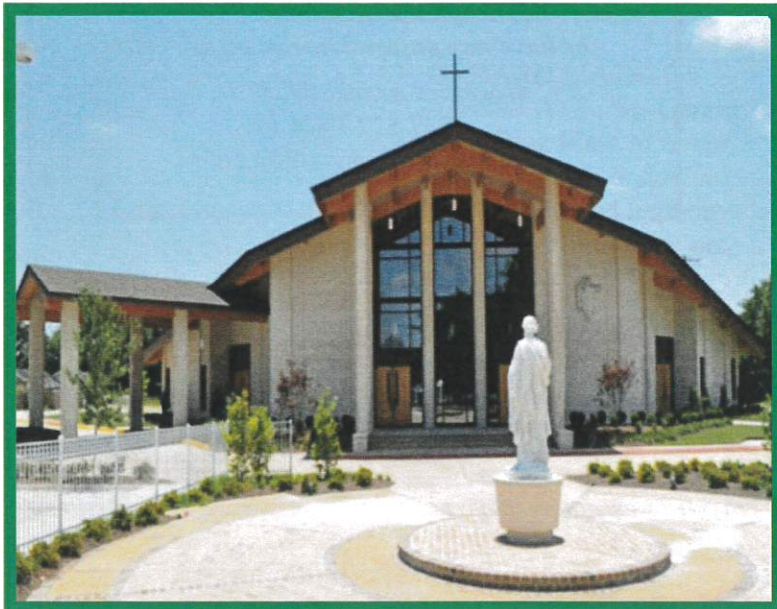

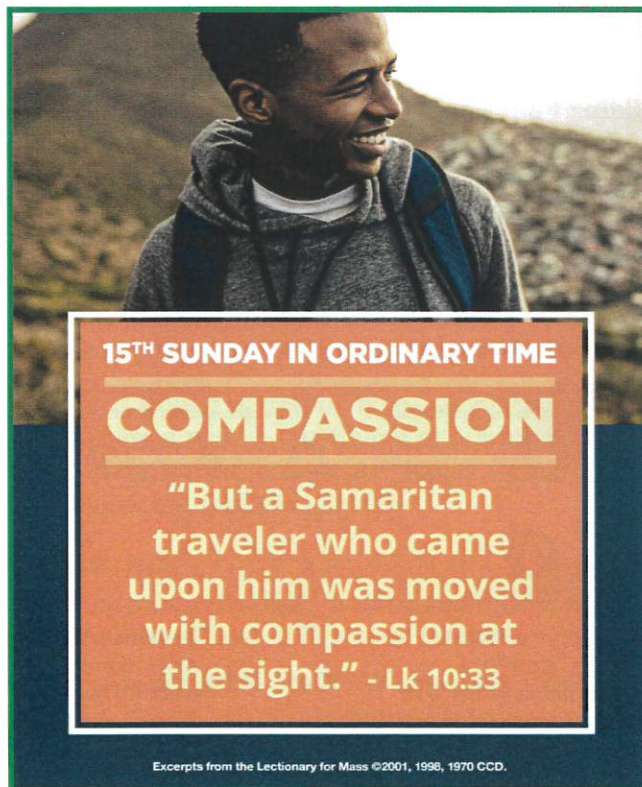

SCHOOL UNIFORMS NEEDED

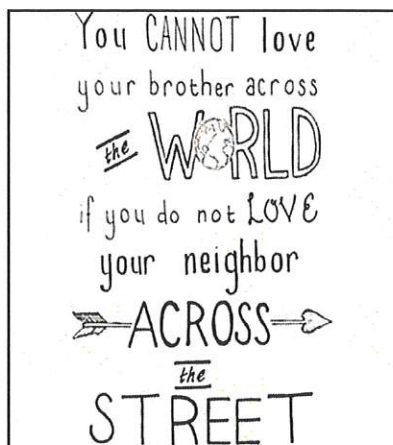
